2. CAC Business

- A. Bond Presentation- Mr. Herbin discussed that the bond allocation was originally \$8 -\$9 million dollars but has been expanded to \$17-\$18 million
- B. The allocation is for a vestibule, security measures, maintenance, adding a school Mental Health Center, and CTE improvements.
- C. Current fences are not secure. The new fencing will be secure, unscalable fencing, and the gates will have egress doors.
- D. Fencing will be added around the portables with the exception of the Communicare Portable.
- E. The front office will be relocated to the Green Tech office space and attendance, registrars, and PEIMS will be housed here. A video camera will als be installed.
- F. Construction of the front office will start right after school is out. There will be an alternate door for those needing to enter the building. Summer School and Summer Bridge will still be held.
- G. The current front office will have a wall added in the current receptionist area to allow for a School Mental Health Center to be added. Our LMHPS will be housed here.
- H. As part of the CTE addition/redesign, the area will include 7100 square feet of space. All Learner Restrooms six of them will be added for the portable area. Sinks will be added on a ½ wall. The modular building will also include a couple of offices, two big labs, a staff restroom, and two large classrooms. The architects worked hard to make the building look permanent. It will also have an

- awning as well as outdoor seating. Vet Tech, Floral, and Ag Science will be relocated to the modular building.
- I. This summer, inside work will take place. Next summer, bond work will include CTE Modular installation and HVAC replacement for the athletic building.

Parent Question:

1. What about students who are tardy? Answer: Herbin - Internal doors will be unlocked to go out, and there are enough openings and exits to allow a good flow. Ms. Miralrio also stated that we will have to problem solve as questions and the unknowns come up.
